# Survey Results

- Total responses 476
- 80% of respondents have or had a dog
- 82.6% of respondents think there is a need for a dog park
- 87.1% of respondents think the park should be fenced
- 62.3% of respondents find it important that the park has lights
- 85.9% of respondents would use the park if conveniently located, and with the right amenities.
- 66.7% of respondents are of the opinion that existing parks should be enhanced to cater for dogs

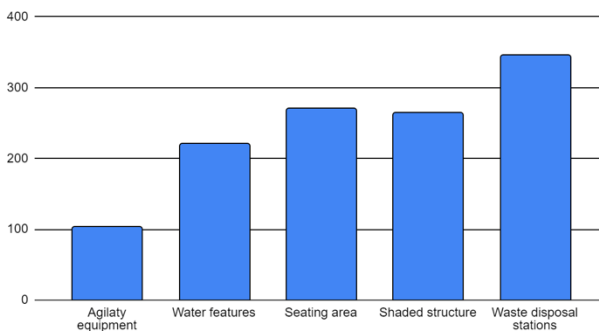

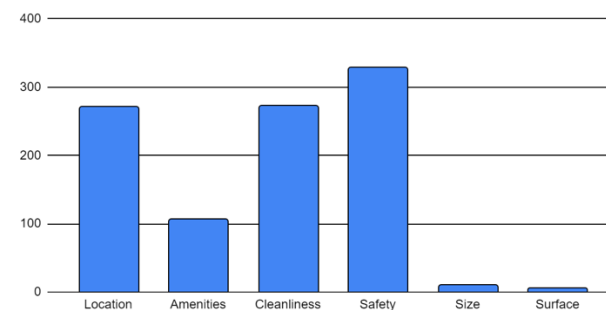

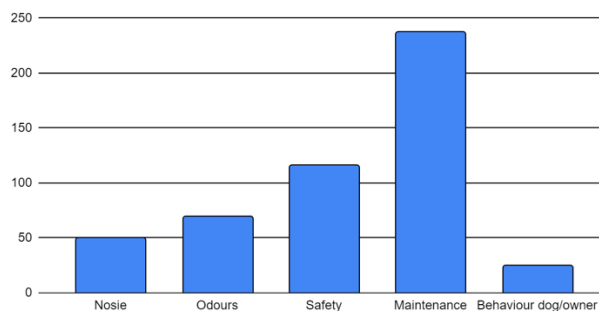
12. What amenities would you like to see in a dog park?



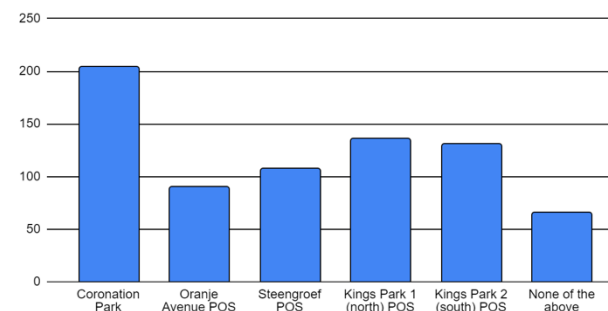
14. What factors would influence your decision to visit a dog park?

## Suggested rules

- No dogs in heat/ill
- No throwing toys
- No dogs after dark
- Vaccinated dogs only
- 2 dog limit
- Leashes carried at all time
- No unsupervised children under 16
